The club's flying site is located on a leased 39 acre tract of land owned by the United States Army Corps of Engineers near Lake Waco. The asphalt paved runway is 800' long by 80' wide making it suitable for all types of aircraft. Over 200' of shaded pit area is onsite with electricity and charging locations for electric aircraft. RV 30 amp electricity is also available for \$15 per day. No sewage, but city of Waco water is also available. Adequate areas are available to construct an RC car track or FPV drone racing course, if enough club members are interested. Vehicle access is by all weather paved roads. In Google Maps, navigate to 1000 Overflow Road, Waco, Texas or Heart of Texas Miniature Aircraft Club.
